As the successful bidder, Ernst Hansch Construction (Hansch) was awarded the Manitoba Infrastructure contract to complete the Grand Rapids bridge rehabilitation project on PTH #6 over the Saskatchewan River.

The scope of work included the supply, fabrication and erection of new expansion joints, rehabilitation of the pier, curbing, sidewalk and concrete deck. Additional work included the installation of anchor bolt assemblies and electrical conduit for street lights and navigation lights.
